If you are preparing to go to college in the fall of 2006 you need to remember these important dates:  
January/February

- Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible
- Make sure you get a GPA verification form if you are applying for the Cal Grant. If your school counselor doesn't have one you can contact your ILP Worker for help in downloading the forms.

March 2:

- If you haven't done it by now, today is the deadline for submitting the FAFSA and the Cal Grant GPA Verification Form! If you already submitted your forms sit back and watch your friends scramble around at the last minute while you say, "I told you so" and feel smug.

**Your ILP Caseworker can help you with all of your forms for college. The forms can be filled out on our computer, at our office, so they go right to the appropriate destination quickly. Contact your ILP Caseworker for assistance.**

**\*\* Beware: Please beware of any sites that ask for money for filing your FAFSA, Cal Grant, or Scholarships. None of these should cost you money to apply for. If you have problems in this area contact your ILP Caseworker to help you straighten it out.**
